We had a brilliant day for our latest development day looking at tri-golf. The children were able to hone their technique for both putting and chipping hitting lots of great shots.





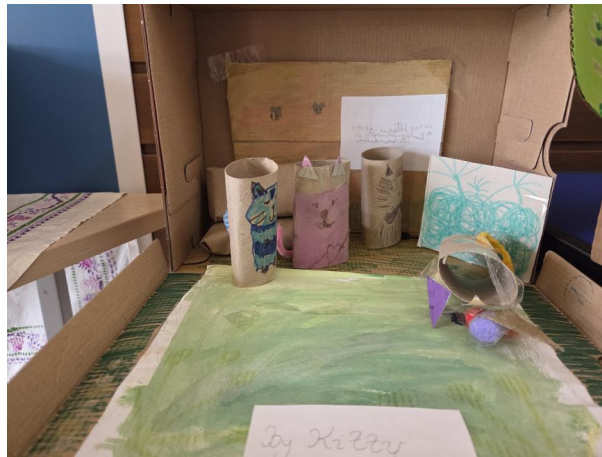
## World Book day
