Around the classes



Next Show **The Princess and  
the Pea**  
Starts at **11:00**

In Buttercups this term we have been writing alternative tales of the Princess and the Pea. We looked at the story told from different perspectives such as the pea. We have been exploring all areas of maths and developed our sense of number through using manipulatives to help us. In Geography we have been comparing our own town to Shanghai, China and looking at different geographical features. In Science we have been looking at habitats by creating our own microhabitats in the forest school. We have also been linking our Art and DT skills with RE. We created kites to celebrate Easter like they do in Bermuda.

In Daffodils this term we started off by finding a dragon's nest outside of the classroom, this led to us each getting our own dragon's eye, from this we drew our dragon, we wrote a spine poem about our dragon, a character description and finally a non-chronological report all about our dragon. In Geography, we have been learning about rivers and the importance of water, we have found where rivers begin and end, what course they take. We have used this knowledge to create river poems in English. In science, we have been looking at habitats and classifying animals. In art, children have used mixed medium to create cave wall art of animals, they came home last week we hope you liked them.

In Sunflowers we have had a hugely busy term. We have been working hard on our dragon stories in our writing. This has involved a range of writing techniques looking at dialogue, suspense and character/setting descriptions. The children have written some fantastic stories and were really proud of their work. In our maths work, we have focused on position and direction and how we can translate and reflect shapes using different co-ordinates. We have loved science where our topic has been light. We have used lots of experiments to help us understand how light travels and how it can bend through different materials as it travels at different speeds. Our art work has looked at portraits and how we can design them in a range of ways. Our geography work has looked at population change and how people are distributed around the world whilst in PE we have enjoyed tennis as well as having all of the apparatus out in our gymnastics lessons.

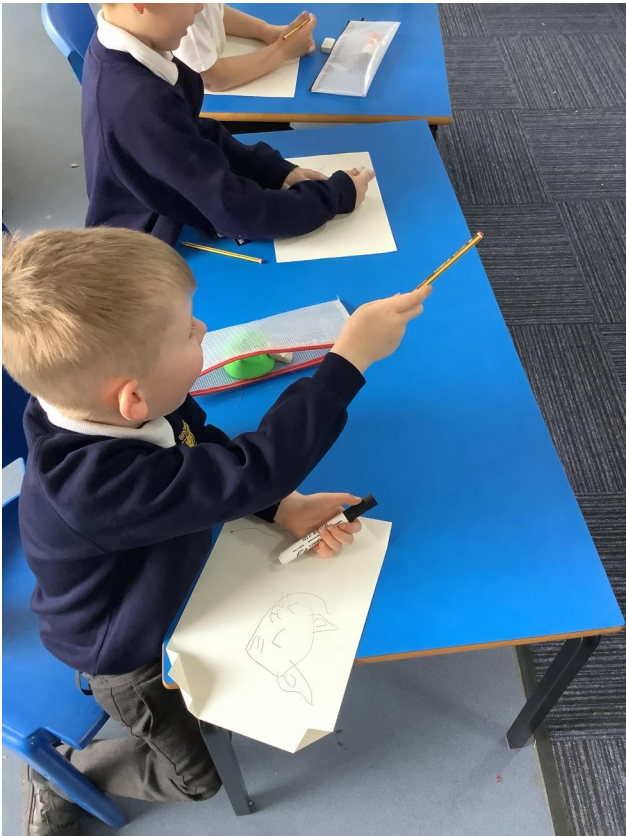

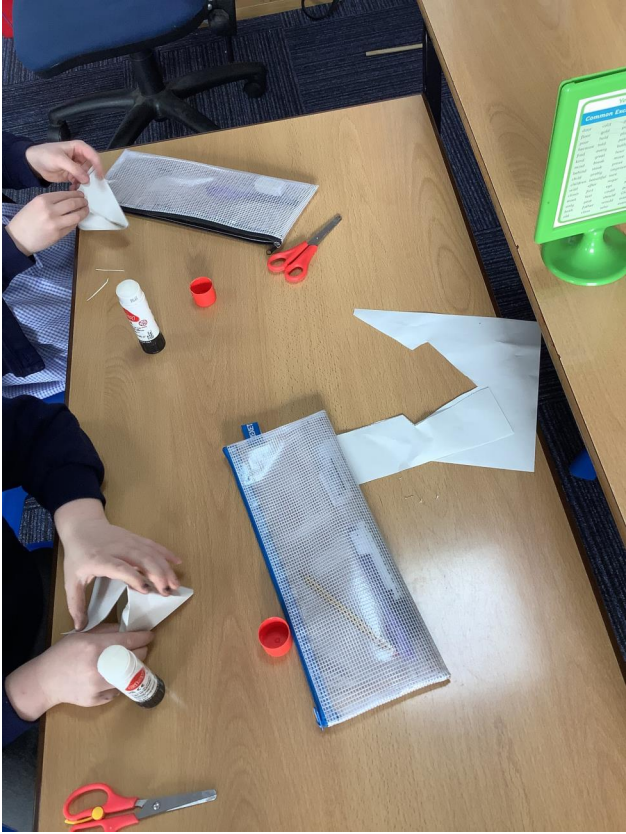












## Learners and Readers
